## VILLAGE UPDATES:

Good and bad: The **large sewer project** should begin in the spring. We got another \$100,000 from a WIIA Grant and an Environmental Facilities Corp/NYS Water Grant but the price of the project has increased from \$750,000 to 1.4 million due to delays.

This project will bring us up to regulatory code and implement mandatory disinfection specifications.

**Old LF School:** Asbestos abatement and roof replacement are underway. There have been delays but the County will be putting out a request for proposals for interested development soon.



## Veterans Banners

ALIVE is planning to honor military veterans and current service personnel who grew up and/or lived in Lyons Falls with the placement of banners along village streets. In addition, historical wartime figures (if possible) will be displayed. Banners will be the same design on both sides.

The price of each banner will be \$170.00.

Doreen created Otis Technology's first product, the Whole Kit and Caboodle, soon after, an invention that would unknowingly innovate gun cleaning and maintenance.
